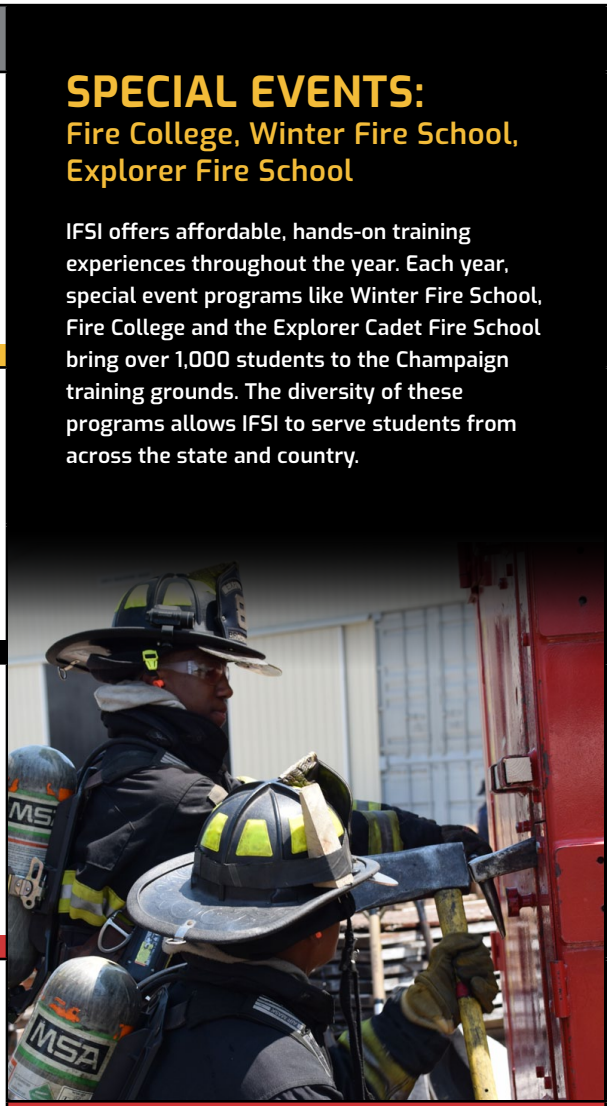

The Illinois Fire Service Institute Library is among the top three fire service dedicated libraries in the nation. It houses a collection of over 65,000 books, articles and reference materials. The extensive emergency response collection is available to students, staff, fire departments, and Illinois residents at the Champaign campus and throughout the state.

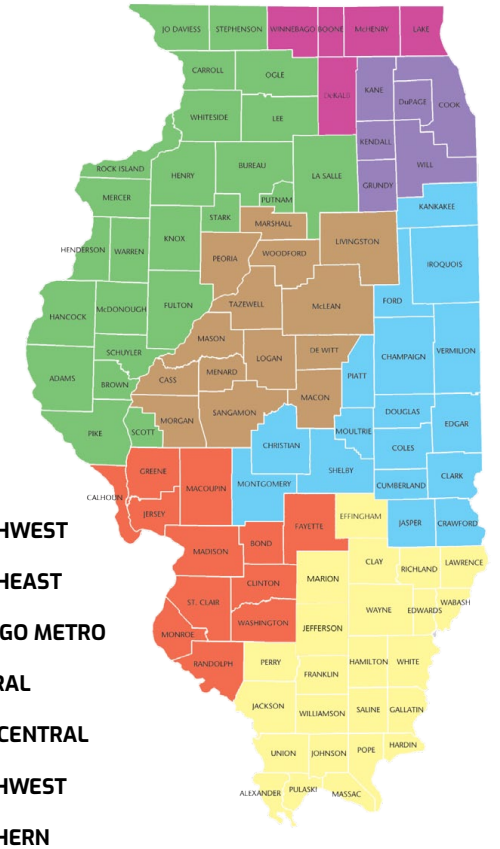
