Course Title: Overhaul and Salvage

Course Duration: 1-16 Hours

Program: Firefighting

Course Description: This class is designed for the firefighter with varying years of experience. In this class the student learns the basic firefighter skills and techniques of Overhaul and Salvage (Loss Control), during classroom and hands on exercises. Upon successful completion of this class, the student will walk away with an increased level of basic firefighter competencies.
